

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Do you sell any bulls before the bull sale?**
No, we do not sell any bulls prior to our sale.
- 2. Do you single trait select in your program?**
No, we do not. We try to piece the genetic puzzle together by balancing traits that are of economic importance to our customers. Buyer feedback shapes our breeding program.
- 3. Do you use a bull just because he won a show?**
No, we do not. We predominately like to use bulls that we have seen the mother of or have seen progeny from. But if a bull does win a show we will not hesitate to use him if our research tells us he can add to our program.
- 4. Do you sell all your bulls in your sale?**
No, we do not sell all our bulls in the sale. We have a selection of bulls that we keep back just in case our customers have a bull get hurt and we also have bulls that we offer for sale by private treaty after the sale.
- 5. Will you be selling any females in your sale?**
No, we will not be selling any females in our bull sale this year but we do offer females for sale by private treaty. Top packages are available... call for details.
- 6. Do I have to take delivery of my bull right away?**
No, we put all the bulls back in their own pens and feed them and keep them until April 1st free of charge.
- 7. Will you deliver my bull?**
Yes, we will deliver your bull up to 250 miles free of charge and at cost after that.
- 8. Are the bulls semen tested?**
No, the bulls are not semen tested at the time of the sale but we will have them tested before they are delivered. With our early sale date none of the bulls are 12 months old so we have our vet scrotal measure them and palpate them before the sale.
- 9. Can I pay 1/2 Down on Sale Day?**
Yes, we offer a 1/2 down payment option. You can pay 1/2 of your purchase price on sale day and give us a post dated cheque dated April 1st for the balance.
- 10. Can I see a mother of a bull before the sale?**
Yes, you may see any cow on the farm prior to the sale. We would recommend you come early or a few days ahead so we have more time to show you around.
- 11. Do you sell semen on your herdbulls?**
No, we do not sell semen on our herdbulls because we like to keep our genetics exclusive and have our herdsires walking in our pastures.
- 12. Do I need to purchase insurance on the bull I buy?**
We strongly recommend you take out insurance on your purchases but if you choose not to, please understand you are responsible for any losses.
- 13. Can you explain what Quadruple Red/Black or Polled means?**
Yes, we use this to document the multi generations of solid colored cattle carrying the polled gene in our pedigrees. A simple red, black or polled means that the animal alone carries that trait. Double signifies that both his sire and dam do; Triple means that every animal in the next generation (grandparents) carry those traits and Quadruple signifies that all the great grandparents are solid colored and/or polled.
- 14. If I buy a red bull carrying black genetics will he sire black calves?**
No, as black color is dominant, once an animal is red he carries no black color genes. A red bull used on red cows will sire all red calves.

Free delivery up to 250 miles - further at cost. Cattle to be delivered should be fully insured. Bulls will be wintered free and then semen tested and delivered in the spring.

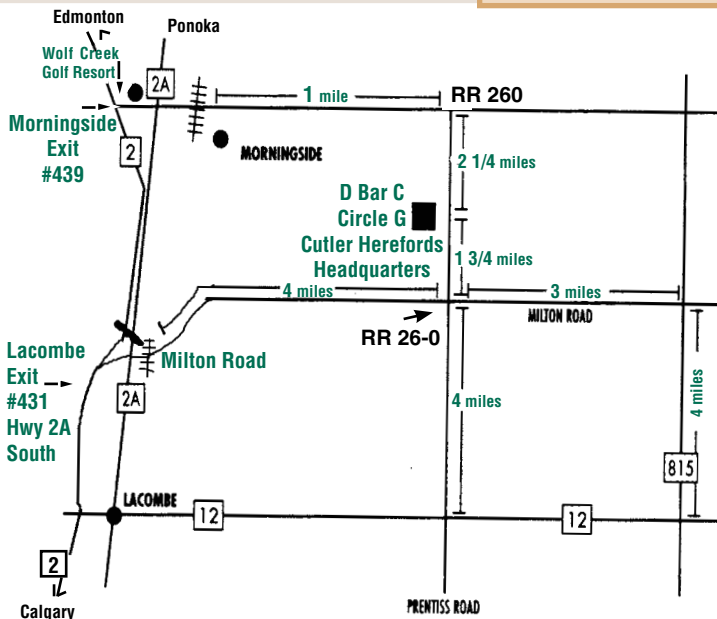
HEALTH:
